

NEIAA Certificate of Achievement Guidance

The NEIAA Certificate of Achievement recognises the contributions of those who recruit eligible patients to the National Early Inflammatory Arthritis Audit.

The following guidance should be followed when awarding a certificate:

- Clinical Leads at rheumatology services participating in the NEIAA are responsible for awarding certificates.
- Certificates should only be issued to individuals who have entered at least five eligible patients into the audit.
- The date range used on each certificate may be determined by the Clinical Lead issuing a certificate.
