It can affect anyone at any age, but a common age of onset RA is

**40-60 years**

The condition mostly affects women, with a female to male ratio of **3:1**

## The 4 Step Process

**1.** You are referred to the Right Start service by your healthcare professional.



**2.** You will receive a scheduled call from a member of our Information & Support team.



**3.** You will then be sent a tailored pack of information from NRAS.



**4.** We will offer you the option of a booked call between yourself and one of our trained volunteers with experience of living with RA.
